Since the t-statistic is less than the t-critical value, we fail to reject the null hypothesis and can conclude that the average screen size of the sample does not differ from 10 cm. We can also verify this from the p-value, which is greater than 0.05. Therefore, we fail to reject the null hypothesis at a 95% confidence interval. A triptych is a work of art (usually a panel painting) that is divided into three sections, or three carved panels that are hinged together and can be folded shut or displayed open. It is therefore a type of polyptych, the term for all multi-panel works. The middle panel is typically the largest and it is flanked by two smaller related works, although there are triptychs of equal-sized panels. The form can also be used for pendant jewelry.
