The surface of the pavement should be stable and non-yielding under heaviest road traffic. This property of the pavement makes the road traffic to move with least possible rolling resistance. The pavement also keeps its temporary elastic deformation within the permissible limits so that it can sustain a large number of repeated load applications during the design life. The upper layer of the Embankment or natural ground whether in cut or fill is termed as sub-grade. Load from the traffic is ultimately distributed on sub grade through other component layers. Therefore, the strength of the sub grade is a basic factor in determining the thickness of pavement.
