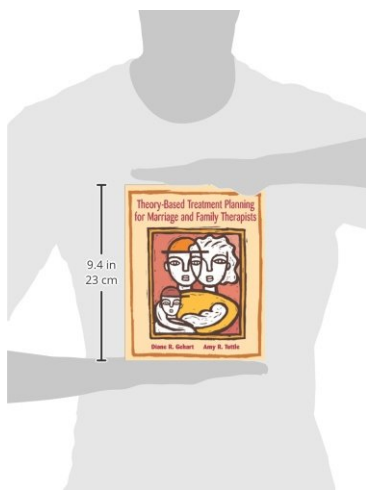

The work of MFT focuses on interactional and relational processes and seeks to build on the clientâ€™s strengths and resources.Â It is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education (COAMFTE), with the majority of the coursework and training process conducted online. The exception to this is the clinical training component, which is described later in this handbook. The MAMFT degree program is focused on developing the clinical skills, as well as the personal and professional growth, that are required for effective practice in the field of MFT.
